### Developmental

We will review and name the colors we have learned so far. Please continue to have your child wear the color of the week.

Our remaining colors (in order):

**Purple** 

Brown

Green

Red

Circle Time: We will learn about the first Thanksgiving and how the Native Americans taught the Pilgrims how to hunt and plant food. We will discuss what we enjoy most about Thanksgiving, including our favorite food at the Thanksgiving meal. We will talk about what it means to be thankful and give each child the chance to say the things for which s/he is thankful. We will learn about the Christmas holiday, Christmas symbols, and decorations.

Art: Bumblebee, Purple Grapes; Handprint Turkey; Christmas Wreath

All books and songs will be on the daily sheets!

### **Primary**

Language: We will continue to introduce capital letters in ABC order. We have learned A-D so far. We play the Alphabet pickup game and alphabet hide and seek to review all the letters we've learned. We sing Thanksgiving songs this month and learn to "parrot" or repeat after our teachers for numbers and objects. We will discuss pilgrims and what it means to be thankful. We will also begin to learn about the Christmas holiday and sing Christmas carols.

**Math**: We will continue to understand the calendar and review the shapes. We will work on naming & recognizing the numbers 2 and 3, as well as starting number lines. We will continue to work on first, last, and positional words such as up, down, over, under, beside, in front of, behind, between

Art: Thanksgiving Surprises and Turkey Art.

**Gross Motor**: This month we will focus on skills associated with kickball!

**Discovery:** We will use our 5 senses to explore fall and make leaf crafts.

### 5-Day Primary

We will focus on writing more independently and developing proper crayon/pencil grip and posture. We will learn the importance of letter formation and page direction. We will begin Dot-to-Dots, which are excellent vehicles to encourage prewriting, sequencing, letter/number recognition, and problem solving skills.

### Pre-K

**Language:** We have started spelling words using our sound picture cards and letters. We are also sequencing the alphabet on our canopies.

### We will meet our 2 Jungle Friends:

1. Lid the Lion

Lid loves to nap; his eyelids are closed and he purrs (l)(l)(l).

2. Dip the Dolphin

Dip's broken tail makes diving difficult, so he splashes (d) into the water.

**Math:** We will continue to discuss shapes and their different characteristics. We will focus on learning and practicing how to place and count objects in a set. We will also be writing the numbers 6 and 7. We will review more and less than and begin patterning.

**Discovery:** We will learn about voting! We will cast ballots for our favorite jungle friend and many of our favorite things! We will learn about Thanksgiving, the Mayflower, Pilgrims, and Native Americans. We talk about the difference between living and non-living things. We will begin to learn about Brazil!

**Art:** All of our art projects this month have to do with Fall and Thanksgiving.

**Gross Motor:** November is a bouncy month in motor class. We are learning the sport of kickball. In order to play well, we have to learn to control the direction of the ball that we kick. Please ask your child about the different types of balls we will use to practice.

## Kindergarten

Reminder: The amount of time you spend reading together makes a huge difference in their success as readers.

**Social Studies**: It's a patriotic month! We will hold our own class election, learn about American symbols and holidays. We will recognize Veteran's Day and have a Thanksgiving feast to remember the first Thanksgiving.

**Reading**: We have individualized reading curriculum for each child, focusing on fluency and comprehension. The students meet with Ms. Mallory during centers to receive one-on-one reading instruction. In whole group lesson, we are learning word families with short a, short o, and short e sounds. Reading comprehension will focus on text features and how to ask questions about our reading.

**Writing**: We will review nouns and learn about pronouns. We will learn to use words and sentences to tell a narrative story with a beginning, middle, and end. We will work to stretch our story across multiple pages and learn how to know when we are done.

**Math**: We will learn about \$1, \$5, and \$10 bills during our unit on money. We will also learn about measuring length using standard and non-standard units. We will use comparative language, such as equal to, greater than, less than, etc. We will act out our story problems - some, some more (addition) and some, some went away (subtraction). We will continue to construct graphs using objects and pictures.

**STEAM**: This month we will be making turkey pens for keeping Tom Turkey contained.

Students are working at their own pace on Education.com, which is the language arts computer program. The kids are really enjoying the Mercy Watson read aloud chapter books! Be sure to ask them what Mercy has been up to.
